

#### What is Worldview-Agility?

Worldview-Agility is an advanced leadership competence, although in essence it's a personal competence everyone would benefit from. It's a very powerful, but still relatively rare competence that will distinguish the average from the excellent future leader.

# What is special about Worldview-Agility?

#### What is a Worldview?

We all have our individual worldviews that result – amongst others – from our personal experiences, educational backgrounds and various conditionings throughout our lives. It's often an unchallenged set of core beliefs that significantly influences the ways we think, feel and act. Core aspects include our personal perspectives on fundamental questions such as:

#### What are different levels of mastery?

Training and building Worldview-Agility – like developing any other competence – requires some time and dedication. It is a process in line with the common steps of learning theory:

- Unconscious Incompetence
- Conscious Incompetence
- Conscious Competence
- Unconscious Competence

It includes three levels of mastery:

- Intellectual Worldview-Agility
- Experiential Worldview-Agility
- Embodied Worldview-Agility

# How do I develop Worldview-Agility?

- Step 1: Exploration of personal Worldview and fundamental belief systems
- Step 2: Introduction of alternative perspectives of reality

- Step 3: Rational, scientific & philosophical evaluation of different Worldviews
- Step 4: Identification of the individually most plausible Worldview
- Step 5: Investigation of Worldview Implications in Life / Business / World
- Step 6: Dealing with tensions resulting from a shifting Worldview
- Step 7: Training agility to consciously switch between perspectives at any time

#### What do I need to invest?

To learn and practice Worldview-Agility you need to invest some time and probably some money, but you certainly must have the right attitude.

The right attitude includes a sufficient level of openness & curiosity and in particular courage to swim against the current. Some of your personal conclusions and findings during the process might turn out to be in contrast to established thought patterns and mainstream knowledge in today's society.

The investments of time and money are loosely interconnected. You will certainly need to spend some time learning, reading, reflecting and probably discussing the subject with others. But there is actually no need to invest money, as you might find a sufficient amount of information freely available on the Internet.

Anyhow, spending some money to buy specific books, sign-up for trainings & seminars, or invest in specific expert coaching & mentoring can significantly reduce the time & effort needed to make good progress.

#### Where do I start?
